HOMESCHOOL PARENT PARTNERSHIP THROUGH HOMEWORKS!

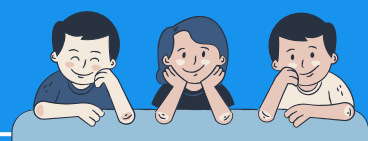


- Engage in traditional homeschooling.

ONLINE INSTRUCTION THROUGH HOMEWORKS!



- Initial core content instruction provided through HomeWorks! teachers.
- Regular student and parent contact required.
- After initial instruction, students learn asynchronously at home for the majority of time.
- Written student learning plans and continuous family engagement are required.



CHENEY HIGH SCHOOL FULL TIME, IN-PERSON



- Attend Cheney High School full time on a four-period day schedule.
- Earn a high school diploma; transcript will reflect traditional high school credits.

THREE SPRINGS HIGH SCHOOL



- Attend Three Springs High School three to five days per week.
- Learn asynchronously up to two days per week.
- Engage in [Summit Learning](#), a project-based instructional approach.
- Earn a high school diploma; transcript will note ALE for credits received in this program.
- Written student learning plans and continuous family engagement are required.
- Engage in weekly mentoring and daily goal setting with Three Springs staff.

ONLINE INSTRUCTION THROUGH THREE SPRINGS HIGH SCHOOL



- Take online courses through [APEX Learning](#).
- Receive support through weekly check-ins with Three Springs teachers and counselors.
- Earn a high school diploma; transcript will note ALE for credits received in this program.
- Written student learning plans and continuous family engagement are required.
- This asynchronous learning model requires students to engage with their learning independently most of the time.

ONLINE INSTRUCTION THROUGH SPOKANE VIRTUAL LEARNING



- Take online courses through [Spokane Virtual Learning](#) taught by SVL teachers and facilitated by Three Springs High School.
- Receive support from SVL and Cheney counselors and specialists.
- Receive support for course planning through Three Springs High School.
- Earn a high school diploma; transcript will note ALE for credits received in this program.
- Written student learning plans and continuous family engagement are required.
- This asynchronous learning model requires students to engage with their learning independently most of the time.

SKILLS CENTER



- Attend some classes at [NEWTech Skills Center](#) to learn career-oriented skills with the potential of earning industry recognized certificates.
- Attend some classes in person at Cheney High School or Three Springs High School.
