



- Learn asynchronously up to two days per week.
- Engage in Summit Learning, a project-based instructional approach.
- Earn a high school diploma; transcript will note ALE for credits received in this program.
- Written student learning plans and continuous family engagement are required.
- Engage in weekly mentoring and daily goal setting with Three Springs staff.

ONLINE INSTRUCTION THROUGH THREE SPRINGS HIGH SCHOOL

- Take online courses through APEX Learning.

ONLINE INSTRUCTION THROUGH SPOKANE VIRTUAL LEARNING

- Take online courses through <u>Spokane Virtual Learning</u> taught by SVL teachers and facilitated by Three Springs High School.
- Receive support from SVL and Cheney counselors and specialists.
- Receive support for course planning through Three Springs High School.
- Earn a high school diploma; transcript will note ALE for credits received in this program.
- Written student learning plans and continuous family engagment are required.
